Awards include a 2009 Children's Book Circle illustration prize, a 2012 EBGE commendation and a 2013 nomination for the Andersen International Illustration Award. She represented Greece at the 2012 Paris Salon du Livre and received the 2016 Peter Pan Award from the Swedish IBBY for best translated picture book. In 2017, she served on the Bologna international illustration exhibition committee.
